The native inhabitants of Oberammergau in Bavaria, Germany present the passion play every 10 years depicting the life and death of Jesus, in thanksgiving for being spared from the bubonic plague. The first performance was in March, 1633, hence, the start of the tradition. This city is also well known for its art of intricate woodcarving.

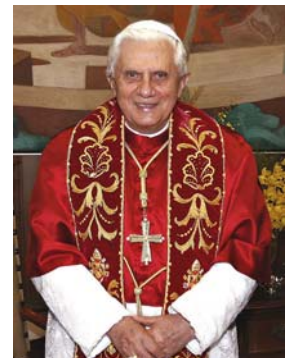
Monday, 20th September 2010: Full day guided city tour of Rome.
